Family	<p>Married couple/partners with or without children.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Single children until 23rd birthday are included in Family Membership 	\$2,500	\$1,300 payable over 5 years. Starts at year 2 of membership
Associate	<p>Married couple/partners, both of whom are under age 40 with no children in grade 3 or above.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> May be held for a maximum of 3 years. Also terminates when either spouse/partner reaches age 40, or the oldest child reaches 3rd grade. 	\$1,240	\$1,300 payable over 5 years. Starts at year 2 of membership but may be deferred until one spouse/partner is age 40
Individual	<p>Single Jewish adults with or without dependents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Single children until 23rd birthday are included in Individual Membership 	\$1,240	\$1,300 payable over 5 years. Starts at year 2 of membership.
Senior Citizen	<p>Congregants aged 67 and over. For couples/partners, at least one spouse/partner must be 67 years of age or older.</p>	\$2250	Does not apply.
Young Adult	<p>See "Young Adult Membership Chart".</p>		
Long Distance/ Out of Town	<p>Members of CSI who have relocated and are living beyond a 60-mile radius from CSI.</p>	\$250	Does not apply.

YOUNG ADULT MEMBERSHIP CHART

Young Adult Out of Town	Child of a current member, who lives beyond 30-mile radius (inclusive of NYC) from the synagogue and is between 23 and 30.	\$140 per Young Adult	Does not apply	Does not apply
Young Adult 23 – 30 years	For 23 – 30 Year Old's who live in the area. Separate rates for singles and couples, but for those without children in grade 3 or above.	\$250	\$300	Does not apply
Young Adult 31 – 40 years	For 31 – 40 Year Old's who live in area with no children in grade 3 or above.	\$495	See Associate category	Does not apply

NOTES RE: BUILDING FUND

Credit for a Building Fund paid to another synagogue may be requested. Upon written confirmation from the synagogue to which the Building Fund was paid, credit of up to \$590 may be given. A minimum obligation of \$710 towards CSI's Building Fund must be made. The member requesting credit must obtain a letter from the previous synagogue stating the exact amount paid to their Building Fund.

All Building Fund payments must be completed by the bar/bat mitzvah date of a family's first child to become a bar/bat mitzvah in our synagogue.

Payment in full of the Building Fund is still required should the member leave the synagogue for any reason.
